

# **Ultrasonographic manifestations of fallopian tube carcinoma in the fimbriated end**

摘要

## **Abstract**

Primary carcinoma of the fallopian tube is the least common malignant neoplasm of the female reproductive tract, accounting for 0.18% to 1.6% of all malignancies.<sup>1-3</sup> Approximately 8% of tubal carcinomas are confined to the fimbriae.<sup>4</sup> Because of its low prevalence, fallopian tube carcinoma is rarely diagnosed before surgery. Recently, ultrasonography has been recommended for the preoperative detection of fallopian tube carcinoma.<sup>5-8</sup> In this report, we present a case of fallopian tube carcinoma arising in the fimbriae and describe ultrasonographic features that should raise the possibility of that diagnosis.
