

Yun Sik Kwak's Biography

Dr. Yun Sik Kwak is the Chair of ISO/TC 215, Health Informatics and he is currently playing a leadership role in medical informatics in Asia as the Chair of Health Level 7-Korea, President of Asia Pacific Association of Medical Informatics (APAMI), Asia Pacific regional representative to IMIA Board, Chair of APAMI WG 1, Standardization and past President of Korean Society of Medical Informatics. He also serves as the Deputy Regional Commissioner for Far East Civilian Laboratories, Commission of Laboratory Accreditation of College of American Pathologists. He had been the founding Chair and Professor of Medical Informatics during 1999-2002 until his retirement at Kyungpook National University School of Medicine and Graduate School in Daegu, Korea. And he stays as the Visiting Professor of Medical Informatics at the same institution for research and teaching. He received M.D. degree from Kyungpook National University in 1961 and Ph.D. degree in Molecular Biology and Pathology from Albany Medical College, Albany, NY, USA in 1972.
