V. Reading Comprehension

Questions 24-33, refer to the following article.

Every cell of our bodies has within its nucleus an instruction manual that specifies its function. Although each cell carries the same manual, different cell types, such as liver or skin, set different parts of this manual to detail their unique *Line* functions. Perhaps most remarkable, the manual contains the information that (5) allows a one-cell embryo, the fertilized egg, to become a fetus and then a newborn child. As the child matures physically and intellectually, he or she is still using the information within the instruction manual. We are each unique, and the manual is slightly different for each of us; it specifies most of the physical and many of the behavioral characteristics that distinguish us as individuals.

(10) This extraordinary manual, otherwise known as the genome, is written in the form of nucleotides - adenylate, cytidylate, guanylate, and thymidylate. It is the precise sequence of the nucleotides in DNA that conveys information, much as the sequence of letters in a word conveys meaning. During each cell division, the entire manual is replicated, and a copy is handed down from the mother cell to

(15) each of its two daughters. In humans and mice, the manuals each contain three billion nucleotides.

If the letters representing the nucleotides were written down in order so that a page carried 3,000 characters, the manual would occupy 1,000 volumes, each consisting of 1,000 pages. Thus, a very complex manual is required to orchestrate (20) the creation of a human or a mouse from a fertilized egg.
