



# 美國 —藥學研究所— 介紹

美國明尼蘇達州立大學藥學研究所博士班

很抱歉到現在才提起筆桿覆信，希望此啟  
礙編輯工作的進行。若有任何不便之處，此致  
。閒話不多提了。言歸正傳，據我所知，從北  
畢業的僑生現旅居於美國者共有三人，計有第  
清梅（來自馬來西亞檳城）目前已是兩個孩子  
，及第八屆的譚維信（香港）及我。譚兄現已進  
vier 大學藥學系臨床藥學的副教授，所以我們  
美國藥學研究所的概況較為貼切，希望這些資  
有志求學的校友有些幫助。

全美國共有七十四間大專學所設有藥學系  
有研究所的有五十六間。據一九七四年的統計  
研究所的共有一千五百人左右，其中來自外國  
七十人之多（約 30 %）從數字看來，在美國  
業的，大部份對研究所不大嚮往，可能是唸研  
後的出路展望並非有很大的吸引力關係。故此  
不少外地人才來維持他們研究發展了。唸藥學  
數佔最高的是來自中華民國（125人），其次  
102人），再次是香港（41人）及韓國（27人  
括來說，差不多每一處藥學研究所，皆可以碰  
的面孔。更不用說是美國的著名藥學雜誌 Jour  
Pharmaceutical Sciences 屢屢會看到不少  
人的稿件。

研究所通常是有藥劑、藥化、生藥、藥理等  
Hospital Pharmacy 之分。各自成一系。但  
的劃分制度是與別不同的，如普渡大學（Pur-  
versity）設有 Bionucleonics, Radiophar-  
Clinical Pharmacy；威斯康辛（Wisconsin）  
Pharmaceutical Biochemistry 及 History  
macy；SUNY at Buffalo 設有 Biochem-  
Biochemical Pharmacology；Kentucky  
eria Medica 等等。

目前最多人就讀的科系是藥劑及藥化。這  
示此兩門是最吃香的出路。最有名氣的幾間是  
Michigan, SUNY-Buffalo, Kansas 及 Ohio  
，教授及研究生衆多，研究經費鉅大，故每  
多個 Teaching 或 Research Assistantship。

攻讀 M.S. 學位需時約兩年，直攻 Ph.D.  
四年，大部份學校目前已趨向多「製造」Ph.D.  
S. Hospital Pharmacy 一科祇設有 M.S.  
，因為外國學生不能領到美國藥劑師執照，而  
生多不被考慮申請。近年來新設的 Pharm.D.  
漸趨普遍，目前已十九間大學開辦。此為

clinical program。關於此 Program 的內容，譚維信同學已於前期的北醫藥學系會刊談論過，不便重覆。藥理系有的是歸併入醫學院裏，藥學系開設的藥理系多是包括毒物學在內。最近美國對於環境污染及安全措施方面十分着重，毒物學此一門已由冷門漸趨向熱門。生藥學現已走向下坡，大學所授的課程很多學校已不包括在內，有者亦是虛有其名，無乎其實。所授者是微生物學、免疫學、抗生素及其他生物製劑的課程。有幾間大學已有打算將生藥學歸入藥化。藥事行政一門比較少外國學生攻讀，而且很難獲得 Assistantship。大部份留學生是由國家派到美國進修此課程的。藥劑的主要課程是 Physical Pharmacy，以 Formulation 一環最容易找到工作。最近藥劑科多加一環 Biopharmaceutics，是研究藥物在體內的吸收，分佈代謝及排泄情形（即是 Pharmacodynamics）。藥物化學以有機化學合成為主，分析為次，天然物化學抽取已漸減少，反之，研究藥物代謝（Drug Metabolism）已大增，畢業後出路亦不錯。

另外要一提的是普渡大學（Purdue）獨家設有的 Bionucleonics（即 Nuclear Medicine 及 Radiopharmacy 一類），雖屬冷門，但畢業後的收入較一般科系畢業生的多一倍，據一位唸 Bionucleonics 的人說他預料他的壽命會縮短六年。你認為值得與否？攻讀公共衛生 M.P.H. degree 亦是明智之舉，哈佛大學的 M.P.H. Program 是首屈一指。藥學系畢業的也可進修基本醫學課程，如生物化學、生理學、微生物學、病理學、臨床化學（clinical chemistry）、解剖學（包括組織學、胚胎學）、藥理學等等。

申請入學的資格是沒有一定的標準，通常是以大學的成績（平均 B 以上）及教授的推薦書為根據，但有些學校，如普渡、俄亥俄州立大學，都需要 GRE (Graduate Record Examination) 來作參考，若能拿到一千便沒問題了。托福（TOEFL）考試不用說是每一屆學生都要通過的一關，最少要拿五百分才算是 O.K.。留學生多是依靠 Teaching Assistantship 或是 Research Assistantship 來維持一切的費用。前者是助教名義，大多不用擔任教書任務，主要是改考卷及準備實驗物品及器材，工作很輕鬆，申請 T.A. 是要看運氣，因為每系所擁有的 T.A. 名額是固定的，若是沒有畢業便沒有 T.A. 的空缺了。T.A. 的聘任期為九個月，薪金由一千八百到四千五百美元不等。Research Assistantship 是由教授個人的研究基金所提出來的

換句話說，R.A. 所擔任的工作都是與他「老闆」的研究有關係的，大部份的工作可歸入自己的畢業論文。申請 R.A. 大多是直接向教授接觸表明你對他的研究有濃厚的興趣，他便會考慮你的申請。另一方面要清楚的是要查明白某位教授擁有充裕的研究費，當然是那些研究活躍的才有政府及其他私人機構資助。以下是一些最近頒發研究費的資料以供參考：
