Johns Hopkins,

Baltimore merchant and banker, left an estate of \$7 million and thirteen acres of land to found two institutions that would bear his name:

"Johns Hopkins University"
"The Johns Hopkins Hospital".



Four outstanding physicians, known as the

"Big Four,"

( William Henry Welch, William Stewart Halsted, William Osler, Howard Atwood Kelly)

to serve as the founding staff of the hospital when it opened in May 1889.

  - U.S. News & World Report "Honor Roll"
  - 1990~2010 in "U.S. News & World Report" as America's hospital ranking winner.
- Among all categories, The John Hopkins ranked no.1 in five fields and no.5 in ten fields.

## **Awards and Honors**

- 20 Nobel Prize winners
- 34 Lasker Award ("The American Nobel") winners (Including faculty, researchers and alumni)
- 23 serving staffs have been nominated for the United States National Academy of Sciences(美國科學院院士)
- 4 staff members and alumni won the Presidential Medal of Freedom (總統自由勳章)

## Medical achievements

- first male-to-female sex reassignment surgery in the United States(1966) that took place in at the Hopkins Gender Identity Clinic.[15]
- discovery of <u>restriction enzymes</u> gave birth to the genetic engineering industry.
- discovery of the brain's natural opiates
- development of <u>HeLa</u>, the first and arguably most important line of human cells grown in culture
- identification of the three types of polio virus
- the first "blue baby" operation, which opened the way to modern <a href="heart surgery">heart surgery</a>. <a href="heart surgery">[16]</a>

- 首先發現試管嬰兒似乎與組織過度生長的生理缺陷有罕見的連結(2002)
- 發展生物性節律點(未來可能成為電子節律點的替代選擇)(2002)

## Achievements

- 不相容捐贈者之間的腎臟移植交換(2003~2009)
- 發展"Safety Checklist": 減少患者的血液感染(2006)
- 經由眼瞼進入頭骨和深層腦部進行手術,取代原先需要打開上半部頭骨的傳統手術方式(2010)

## "PillCam" technology

- 舊型的口服膠囊式攝影 機要等到排出患者體外 之後才能讀取影像
- PillCam可即時傳送影像, 且醫師可以進行遠距診 斷
