

Laparoscopic electrodesiccation of an interstitial pregnancy

Abstract

OBJECTIVE: To report on the case of a woman who presented with lower abdominal pain and vaginal bleeding, and who was diagnosed with early interstitial pregnancy. DESIGN: Case report. SETTING: Medical center and teaching hospital. PATIENT: A 32-year-old woman with a previous history of ectopic pregnancy. INTERVENTION(S): Imaging study with ultrasonography and laparoscopy. MAIN OUTCOME MEASURE(S): Complete resolution of the ectopic pregnancy at the interstitial site of the amputated fallopian tube, and resumption of menstruation. RESULT(S): Other causes of internal bleeding were ruled out. Menstruation resumed 30 days after the procedure. CONCLUSION: An early interstitial pregnancy may be successfully managed with laparoscopic electrodesiccation.
